Basic and EMD Con-Ed Schedule

One hundred twenty hours within four years, of continuing education, seminars, and workshops, addressing both adult and pediatric care are required for the EMT Basic to relicense.

EMD requires 24 hours in two years to relicense

The ACMC EMS Academy Con-ed sessions are approved by IDPH to meet those requirements.

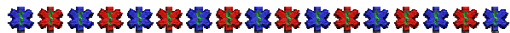
Continuing education is offered on the third Wednesday of every month, except November and December. A variety of topics are scheduled throughout the year.
